We bring to your notice the Dress Regulations and Rules for Verandah Area. We request all members and their guests to strictly adhere to the same.

- **Smoking in any mode is strictly prohibited**
- **Dress Regulations:**

6.00am to 8.00pm

MEN: Round / V neck T-shirts, Shorts (Formal, Rowing attire shorts, Regular Gym shorts), Capri Pants, Track Pants, Collared Shirts (including Chinese collar) & Collared T-shirts, Formal / Casual Trousers, Jeans, Kurtas with collar and Dhotis.

WOMEN- Regular Sports attire, Indian wear & Western wear

After 8.00 pm

MEN: Collared Shirts (including Chinese collar) & Collared T-shirts, Formal / Casual Trousers, Jeans, Kurtas with collar and Dhotis. Track pants and Shorts strictly not permitted.

WOMEN: Indian wear & Western wear

- **Footwear Regulations:** Formal Shoes, Sport Shoes, Sandals (Open or Buckled), Floaters, Sneakers, Heels and Regular Ladies wear. **Rubber slippers, Flip flops strictly not permitted**
- Members and guests not to use this facility in sweaty clothes (especially change your top sweat wear after your sporting activity)
